Dr. Currier is Professor of Medicine, Executive Vice Chair for Research and Co-Director of the Center for AIDS Research and Education Center (CARE) in the Department of Medicine at University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA). She currently serves as Chair of the ACTG Network. She has been involved in the clinical care of people with HIV for over twenty-five years. Her research has focused on HIV therapeutics and long-term complications of HIV disease with an emphasis on sex differences and antiretroviral therapy, cardiovascular disease, and women's health.
